**The Washington Center Federal Diversity Internship Initiative** - a fully funded, paid internship program with various federal agencies.

The Washington Center is currently looking for qualified candidates to apply for our 2016 spring and summer internship opportunities. If accepted, students will receive **free, fully-furnished housing** close to their internship location, a twice-monthly **stipend**, and professional guidance from a TWC adviser.

Students will have a chance to intern for **10 or 15 weeks** at a Federal Agency in a position within the fields of aviation, business, human resources, computer science, healthcare, statistics, communications, library science, environmental science, geographic information systems, public administration and engineering. Additionally, TWC encourages students from many **diverse backgrounds** to apply - including women, minorities and students with disabilities.

To apply, interested students must submit an application by **November 18, 2015** (for the spring semester), or **January 15, 2016** (for the summer term).
