

Travel by train: The easiest way to get to and from the museum is to walk from the Renaissance Grand Hotel to the Convention Center Station (go from B to A in the figure below and to the left) of the Metrolink light rail system, purchase (about \$2) and validate a one-way ticket, and please make sure to take a Westbound train bound for Shrewsbury (not for the airport) to the Skinker Station (on the way back you can take any Eastbound train) and walk to the art museum (go from A to B in the figure below and to the right). If you would like to follow along with a group of people, a number of us will meet in the hotel lobby at 6pm, and will leave to walk to the train at 6:10pm.







Travel by car/taxi (8 miles, 15 to 20 minutes, see route map below): Go south on 8th St. and turn right onto Market St. Turn left onto 10th St. and take the on-ramp onto highway US-40/I-64. After a little under 6 miles, take the Skinker/Clayton exit and turn right onto Skinker Blvd. Turn left onto Forsyth Blvd, right onto Hoyt Dr, and right onto Brookings Drive. If driving, please use a metered parking space along Brookings Drive.
